Today's 5 verses, read in order, are from Christ's revelation to John concerning Christ's conquering of Satan the Devil.

a "So the great dragon was thrown out—the ancient serpent, who is called the Devil and Satan, the one who deceives the whole world. He was thrown to earth, and his angels with him."

b "Then I heard a loud voice in heaven say: The salvation and the power and the kingdom of our God and the authority of His Messiah have now come."

Revelation 12:10 (2 of 5 for Jun 4)

c "The accuser of our brothers [Satan the Devil] has been thrown out: the one who accuses them before our God day and night."

Revelation 12:10 (3 of 5 for Jun 4)

d "They conquered [Satan the Devil] by the blood of the Lamb and by the word of their testimony, for they did not love their lives in the face of death."

Revelation 12:11 (4 of 5 for Jun 4)

e "Therefore rejoice, you heavens, and you who dwell in them! Woe to the earth and the sea, for the Devil has come down to you with great fury, because he knows he has a short time."

Revelation 12:12 (5 of 5 for Jun 4)



USAGE OF THE NAME OF GOD IN THESE VERSES AND STUDIES

As I do in all my Daily and Additional Verses, whenever an OT passage contains the four-letter Name of God יהוה (transliteration: YHVH or YHWH), I change the translation from The LORD to Yahweh. (***Yahweh*** seems to be the most common transliteration of the name, but I have recently come across some very persuasive arguments that the name was originally pronounced ***Yehovah***, with the accent on the last syllable.)

I don't make this change for reasons of doctrine. It is *simply not true*, as some teach, that my prayers will not be heard or that I will lose (or not gain) my salvation *if I pronounce the name of God incorrectly*. (Read Psalm 44:20-21.)

I bring forth the name of God simply because, 6,828 times in the Hebrew Bible (Old Testament), ***the word is a proper name***. (See Exodus 3:15 below.)

And as such, I believe to read the text in a way that uses a proper name (and not a title, like Lord) conveys more accurate information. Paul told us that "All Scripture is inspired by God," and so why wouldn't we want to read it the way He inspired it? While it is true that the correct pronunciation of YHWH has been lost over the millennia, "Yahweh" is probably our era's most commonly used equivalent.

God also said to Moses, "Say this to the Israelites: Yahweh, the God of your fathers, the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob, has sent me to you. This is My name forever; this is how I am to be remembered in every generation."


